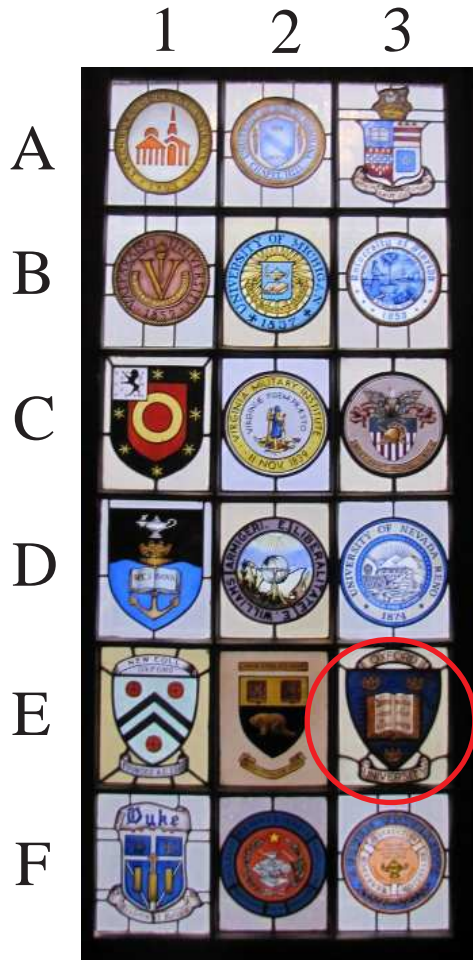

E-3 in the above window, #3, would be Oxford University, circled in red. The windows are numbered beginning with the window closest to the College Room fireplace. See the brass plaque on the windowsill for the window number.

You are sitting in the College Room of The University Club. This “great baronial dining hall” was one of the first commissions of Denver’s noted architect Temple Buell in 1923 and the first major addition to our clubhouse which was built in 1895 and first occupied in 1896.

The College Room is the venue for the Club’s annual “Twelfth Nite” performances as well as the annual meetings for our membership. The balcony on the east wall is the king’s throne during “Twelfth Nite,” when “mirth is unrefined.” Lunch is served daily and the room is often used for special events or receptions.

Notice the sturdy oak dining room chairs- a tradition since 1964. They are inscribed with the names and colleges of many of our members- past and present.

The great fireplace at the south end of the hall was a memorial gift from Karen Rodgers, the widow of the Club’s first President, Henry Treat Rodgers. Over the firebox is the Club’s official seal, which includes a memorial tower from the Yale campus. This seal was designed by Yale alumni, James Grafton Rodgers and Richard H. Hart and celebrates the Club’s formation and founding in 1891.

Now look to the large windows on the west and north walls. For nearly a century, these college seals have adorned our clubhouse. Members may add the emblem of their respective Alma Mater or to honor the memory of a deceased member. This is the same tradition we have for the oak dining room chairs.
